

Changing Views Using Data Filters, Drop Down Selections and Graphing

Within each data display option there are data filters and drop down selections which will change the data displayed. These filters allow for more general or more granular data views. Graphing is also available for labs, vitals and medication administrations.

To Access the Physician's Clinical Portal:

- Click on the Portal icon 
- Enter your user ID and password

Your Patient List

Your patient list is created based on existing patient/physician relationships such as admitting or consulting physician. You have the option to add patients in order to establish a new relationship.

Patient List Management

To ADD a patient to your list:

- Click on the ADD button or PATIENT SEARCH tab.
- Enter search criteria
- Select the patient and visit(s) you wish to view.
- Define the relationship, i.e. Consultant.
- Click on Add.

To REMOVE a patient from your list:

- Click on the REMOVE button.
- Your list of patients will be presented.
- Click on the patient(s) you wish to remove.
- Click the Remove button.

FILTERS can be chosen from a drop down box to alter the display of patients, i.e. by facility, by physician group, by diagnosis.

Patient Data Display Area

After selecting a patient from your patient list, you are able to view specific patient data displayed on the right side of the screen.

- A list of display options is available for you to select data detail.
- Filters are available to change time frames for viewing or to select specific types of data to view, i.e. History & Physical Reports

Data Display Options

- **Pt Summary** – lists all unviewed clinical data
- **Overview** – summary of pt visits and notes
- **Patient Detail** – patient demographics for most recent visit
- **Visits** – provides details for visit such as account number and providers
- **Allergies** – list of available known allergies
- **Clinical Notes** – list of all clinician notes, i.e. dictated physician reports, nurses notes
- **Medications** – list of medications including the MAR
- **Lab Results** – lab results are displayed in a variety of user defined options such as panels and tables
- **Order Status** – list of current orders and status
- **Test Results** – all other clinical results such as x-rays, microbiology and anatomical pathology
- **Vitals & I/O** – tabular display of data
